Karanga Wānanga (Level Two):

Beginners' classes in Karanga: This is a course for women wishing to learn about karanga and its associated roles and responsibilities. Learn how to find that voice deep inside yourself and take ownership of developing that taonga within. This is an introductory course - you do not have to be fluent in te reo Māori. We open the door to marae tikanga, te reo Māori and our Māori world view.

There are four wānanga during the year to complete the course. Here are some of the kaupapa covered:

- Cosmological origins of the Māori people
- Atua Wahine stories
- Marae protocols
- Mōteatea/karakia
- Karanga techniques
- Karanga roles and responsibilities
- Inner spiritual awakening of self
